REACH for Gold Points at your Local Club!

6-Day Side-Series Regional Pairs Event at Your Local Club

During the week of **Feb 3, 5-9**, the ACBL is piloting a collaboration across the Chesapeake Regional, The Common Game, USBF and local clubs in your area. Individual players will be eligible to win Gold Points based on their results in their Common Game “afternoon” games.

Players who would like to win Gold Points will register and prepay online to be eligible to participate in the Regional event. Then, you simply go to your local club to play in the “afternoon” game(s). Your Club plays the “afternoon” Common Game hand as usual. (Those who do not want to participate in the Regional event can still play in the afternoon game as usual, they just won’t be eligible for the extra points).

Players must play in at least two games that week and may play in up to five games. The average of the resulting two best scores will be used to determine your event rank. You can play with different partners as you compete as an individual in the Regional Side-Series game and as a partnership in your regular club game at the same time. There will be an optional practice game before the event for players to get comfortable with the concept.

When:

- February 3, 5-9, 2018

Cost: You must pre-register and pay \$30 to be eligible for Regional Event Gold Points (this is in addition to the normal card fee at your club)

What you will need to do:

Clubs:

- Play the afternoon Common Game hand records as usual - that’s it!

Players:

- You will need to [pre-register](#) for this event to be eligible to win Gold Points.
- If you’d like to participate in a **practice round** the week of Jan 22-27. There is no extra cost for the practice (just the regular entry fee at your club). You can sign up [here](#) or by visiting the website below. The practice game winner will receive a week of free entries at their local “Afternoon” club game provided by TCG.
